

Fully vaccinated Indian travellers can now travel to France

Atout France – France Tourism Development Agency has announced that since July 17, all fully vaccinated travellers coming from countries classified as green, orange or red can enter France without restriction or without a compelling reason irrespective of the red, amber or green classification implemented by France. This implies that fully vaccinated Indians can travel to France. As of 18th July, France has also recognised Covishield in its list of approved vaccines. Travel is possible only 2 weeks after the second dose of Covishield has been administered. Further information on visas and travel modalities will be shared once more details are available.

Vistara launches flights from Delhi to Tokyo

Vistara has started to operate special non-stop flights between Delhi and Tokyo starting June 16. The airline is supposed to run once a week on Wednesdays (Delhi-Tokyo) and Thursdays (Tokyo-Delhi) under India and Japan travel bubble agreement. The airline will be operating its Boeing 787-9 Dreamliner aircraft.

Qatar Re-Opens For Fully VaccinatedInternational Travellers

The State of Qatar has re-opened its borders to international travellers who have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19, with vaccines that are approved for use by the Ministry of Public Health in Qatar. In order to visit Qatar – international visitors, citizens and residents – must register and upload required documentation such as a vaccination certificate, valid PCR test up to 72 hours prior to travel, and personal details through the 'Ehteraz' website (www.ehteraz.gov.qa).

Travellers have to apply for the authorization through the 'Ehteraz' website (free of charge), at least 12 hours before their planned departure to Qatar. All in-bound travellers are advised to submit their application as soon as they have all their required documentation, to ensure they can board their flights as planned. Airlines are advised to only let passengers board who have a valid travel authorisation for Qatar from the above effective date. In addition, visitor visa rules apply for certain nationalities, however over 80 nationalities can visit Qatar with a free 'visa on arrival'.

Oman indefinitely suspends flights from 24 countries, including India

On July 8, Oman has suspended passengers flights from 24 countries, including India, Bangladesh, and Pakistan indefinitely, as part of the Gulf nation's efforts to contain the spread of Coronavirus. The countries that have been included in the list include the United Kingdom, Lebanon, Tunisia, Iraq, Iran, Brunei, Libya, Indonesia, Singapore, the Philippines, Sudan, Ethiopia, Ghana, Tanzania, South Africa, Guinea, Sierra Leone, Nigeria, Colombia, Brazil, and Argentina.

"Freedom Day" in the UK as the country removes all the COVID restrictions from July 19.

After remaining in stringent lockdown for a long time, the United Kingdom has finally lifted all the COVID restrictions from today. The government has decided to reopen all the clubs, pubs and restaurants in the country to their full capacity. British media is calling July 19, 2022, as the "Freedom Day".

The UK government said that twothirds of the adult population is now fully vaccinated and the risk can be managed. That's the reason they are risking reopening the economy to the fullest.

India To Issue First 5 Lakh Tourist Visas For Free To Boost Tourism...

Five lakh tourist visas will be issued free of charge - once the government resumes issuance -Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said today, as the government unveiled a list of eight relief measures for some of the sectors worst affected by the Covid pandemic and lockdown. This scheme will run till March 31, 2022, or till the first five lakh (0.5 million) tourist visas are issued, whichever is earlier, Sitharaman said, adding that each tourist could only avail of this scheme once.

Travel and tourism sector is among the sectors most badly hit by the pandemic.

Canada reopens to fully vaccinated US travellers from 9 Aug and to rest of world from 7 Sept

Canada has announced it will allow fully vaccinated US citizens into
Canada on 9 August and those from the rest of the world from 7
September. The 14-day quarantine requirement will be waived as of 9
August for eligible travellers who are currently residing in the US and have received a full course of a COVID-19 vaccine approved for use in Canada.

Canadian officials also announced that children who aren't vaccinated but are travelling with vaccinated parents won't have to quarantine, but will have to avoid group activities.


